

Volunteering in a School in Deva, Romania 2019

A visit to Romania had already been arranged through "Volunteer Romania" to work in a Special Needs Unit in Deva. The intention of the OT was to take resources and model the use of these in such a way as to have an ongoing impact. OT Frontiers provided a grant to enable resources to be purchased in the UK. After the visit the following feedback and photographs demonstrate the outcome.

We had a very positive trip and were able to spend some wonderful time with the children there developing play skills, and also providing information to the school staff about different ways to work with the children.

With the funding OT Frontiers provided we were able to make 4 'therapy kits' to take with us, each containing an array of sensory and play resources that we were able to use with the children, and leave with the school. During our time there we were also able to find resources in the nearby town, Deva, and advised the school of suitable replacements / alternatives.
